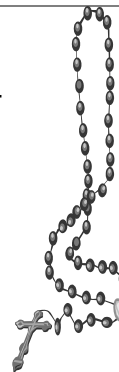

**The Upcoming Revised English Translation of the Mass: The *Sanctus***

**NEW TEXT (Change in bold)**

Holy, Holy, Holy Lord God of **hosts**.  
Heaven and earth are full of your glory.  
Hosanna in the highest.  
Blessed is he who comes  
in the name of the Lord.  
Hosanna in the highest.

**COMMENTARY**

The first two lines are a quotation from Isaiah 6:1-3, in which Isaiah describes a vision of the Lord's heavenly temple in which the highest choirs of angels sing: "Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord of hosts."

*Hosts* means "armies," referring to the armies of angels that God commands (e.g., Matthew 26:53).

The last lines refer to Matthew 21:9: "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!"

The *Sanctus* is a point when the Mass being celebrated on earth is connected to the divine worship being offered to God in Heaven.
