**FROM FR. DAVE’S DESK**

This weekend I have taken a trip with several men from our Diocese who are Juniors in High School and older, who will join many more from all around the country visiting Conception Seminary College. One of our biggest hurdles to priestly vocations, is that we have made “going to the seminary” and “deciding to be a priest” the same thing. One does not “decide he’s going to be a priest” and so he “goes to the seminary!” These young men sense the possibility of that call and must have some open-ness to it, but they go to the seminary as a way to listen more intently to that call. Some, upon that intent and focused listening, hear that they are not called and they go a different direction. This too is what they needed—to know that they have listened for and to God. Others will begin to see Priesthood as God’s plan for them. Please pray for all seminarians, but also for all those who are sensing that they might be called to spend time listening more closely to God by going to seminary or a house of formation of a religious order. Pray also, for the peace and wisdom for ourselves to encourage but not force; to support, but not pressure; but most of all that WE can lovingly accept whatever God’s will is for others and help them to follow it.
