## WHAT'S GOING ON IN YOUTH MINISTRY

Listed below are components 3 & 4 for Youth Ministry. While there is a coordinator of Youth Ministry (CYM) it will take our whole parish working to address these components.

3. **Community Life: creating** an environment which nurtures meaningful relationships among youth and between youth and adults characterized by Gospel values (e.g. acceptance of all people; trust, respect, cooperation, honesty, taking responsibility, willingness to serve); **helping** young people feel like a valued part of the church community; **providing** opportunities for social interaction and meaningful participation in the life of the church and civic community.

4. **Evangelization: proclaiming** through word and witness the Good News of the Gospel to youth who have not yet heard or seen it and **inviting** them into a relationship with Jesus Christ and the community of believers; **ongoing witness** of the faith community as it attempts to live out the Gospel with such authenticity that the faith of all the members is sustained and nourished. Evangelization is the energizing core of all the components of youth ministry (The Challenge of Catholic Youth Evangelization)
