April 7, 2009

Approval of Minutes

Shari LePage moved to approve the minutes, Melissa Lorts seconded. The March minutes were approved.

Principal's Report

Mrs. Struempf reported on the following:

- The spelling bee winners from IC for the diocese were 5th grader Josiah Imhoff who took 2nd place; 6th grader Chris Bosch who took 5th place; and 8th grader Becky Thompson who took 1st place.
- Teacher contracts are due back by Wednesday, April 15. No one has given any indication that they will not be returning.
- Easter break is Thursday, April 9 to Tuesday, April 14. Classes will resume on Wednesday, April 15.
- The Kindergarten through fifth grade have the opportunity to participate in "Food Power" on Wednesday, April 29 at East School. The students will participate in groups of 7 or 8 students.
- May crowning will be May 1st at an all school mass.
- Graduation is May 17.
- The school will start next year on August 17, 2009 and end on May 19, 2010.
