First Reading: Isaiah 43:16-21

Jesus straightened up and said, "Let anyone among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her."

**Adult Question:** Have you ever been too willing to "cast the first stone" when you disapproved of someone's behavior? How can you resist these feelings?

**Child Question:** When have you criticized or made fun of someone? What could help you act differently?

### WHY PRAYER

**In our Catholic tradition, we are called to deeper prayer during Lent.** One way of prayer is conversation with our Maker, our Savior. Prayer builds our relationship, our friendship with God. Think of your other friendships; those relationships to which we do not give time often drift and lose their life. God does not move away from us; rather, we tend to move away from God when we don't pray regularly. Prayer allows time to reflect on where the Lord has been present in the day, where he is tugging at our heart – inviting us to be Him in our everyday joys and struggles. Lent is a time to pull up a chair next to our God and talk to Him about your day. This conversation is sometimes challenging, but always loving and honest. And then we move quietly to simply resting in the presence and embrace of our God – in gratitude and hope.
